# SIX ENEMIES OF EVERY BELIEVER Proverbs 27:1-8

#### 1. Pride or arrogance:

Proverbs 27:1, 2, "Boast not thyself of tomorrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth. Let another man praise thee, and not thine own mouth; a stranger, and not thine own lips."

- A. Boasting of achievements.
- B. Praising yourself in open or subtle ways.

## 2. Anger or uncontrolled temper:

Proverbs 27:3, "A stone is heavy, and the sand weighty; but a fool's wrath is heavier than them both."

- A. The "stone" stands for the obvious type of anger, the explosive anger.
- B. The "sand" speaks of a subtle type of anger.

# 3. Envy and jealousy:

Proverbs 27:4, "Wrath is cruel, and anger is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy?"

- A. This is worse than loss of temper, according to this verse in context.
- B. Ananias and Sapphira illustrated the green-eyed monster of jealousy.

#### 4. Pseudo love:

Proverbs 27:5, 6, "Open rebuke is better than secret love. Faithful are the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy are deceitful."

- A. The "infatuated with Jesus" crowd is in love with love. It's like puppy love in the spring time, gushing over, very shallow, absolutely meaningless. This is the "glory, hallelujah" crowd.
- B. Only the filling of the Holy Spirit produces love (AGAPE), and only maturity in the soul produces a total soul rapport of love (PHILOS).

### 5. Indifference to the Word of God:

Proverbs 27:7, "The full soul loatheth an honeycomb; but to the hungry soul every bitter thing is sweet."

- A. The details of life are more important than the Word of God.
- B. "Honey" is a perfect illustration of the Word of God, so get it at all costs.

#### 6. A false scale of values:

Proverbs 27:8, "As a bird that wandereth from her nest, so is a man that wandereth from his place."

- A. He won't give up his social life to get the Word.
- B. He won't go on a crash program of getting the Word of God.
- C. Therefore he spends his time building a pseudo-maturity in the soul.

Of course, these six enemies of every believer are also occupational hazards of the so-called "Christian Workers." But all are in full-time Christian service, so the above is applicable to ALL believers.
