THE SEVEN WORST SINS IN THE BIBLE Proverbs 6:16-19

In this passage are seven things that God hates: The phrase "an abomination," means the worst. There are four sins of the tongue, and two mental attitude sins, and one overt sin.

1. "A PROUD LOOK."

This comes through the eye gate. This is a mental attitude sin of pride. Pride plus lust equals jealousy. This is thinking pride, wicked imaginations.

2. "A LYING TONGUE." Lying here is a habitual liar. A sin of the tongue.

3. "HANDS THAT SHED INNOCENT BLOOD."

This is murder, killing is prohibited.

A. Exodus 20:13, "Thou shalt not kill," literally in the Hebrew it is, "Thou shalt not murder."

4. "A HEART THAT DEVISETH WICKED IMAGINATIONS."

This is the mind controlled by the emotions and this is a mental attitude sin. This is a mind filled with jealousy. Jealousy which breeds suspicion and suspicion thinks the worst. The worst in the mind is the imagination.

5. "FEET THAT BE SWIFT IN RUNNING TO MISCHIEF."

This is a sin of the tongue and overt sin. This is a person going around making trouble. Most trouble is caused by the use of the tongue, which involves gossip, resulting in overt sin, making trouble for others.

6. "A FALSE WITNESS THAT SPEAKETH LIES."

This is another sin of the tongue: Perjury, downgrading someone. This is playing spiritual king of the mountain.

7. "HE THAT SOWETH DISCORD AMONG THE BRETHREN."

Sin of the tongue, maligning.
