80 REASONS WHY I BELIEVE IN CREATION

- 1. Genesis 1:1-3 "In the beginning God created the heaven and the Earth. And the Earth became void and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light, and there was light."
- 2. Exodus 20:11 "For in six days the Lord made heaven and Earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day, wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it."
- 3. 1 Samuel 2:8 "He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set them among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory, for the pillars of the Earth are the Lord's, and He hath set the world upon them."
- 4. Nehemiah 9:6 "Thou, even Thou, art Lord alone: Thou has made Heaven the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the Earth, and all things that are therein, the seas, and all that is therein, and Thou preservest them all, and the host of Heaven worshippeth Thee."
- 5. Job 12:8, 9 "Or speak to the Earth, and it shall teach thee, and the fishes of the sea shall declare unto thee. Who knoweth not in all these that the hand of the Lord hath wrought this?"
- 6. Job 26:7 "He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the Earth upon nothing."
- 7. Job 26:13 "By His Spirit He hath garnished the heavens, His hand hath formed the crooked serpent."
- 8. Job 28:24-26 "For He looketh to the ends of the Earth, and seeth under the whole heaven: to make the weight for the winds, and He weigheth the waters by measure. When He made a decree for the rain, and a way for the lightning of the thunder."
- 9. Job 37:16 "Dost thou know the balancings of the clouds, the wondrous works of Him which is perfect in knowledge?"
- 10. Job 37:18 "Hast thou with Him spread out the sky, which is strong, and as a molten looking glass?"
- 11. Job 38:4 "Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the Earth? Declare, if thou hast understanding."
- 12. Job 38:7-10 "When the morning stars sung together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? Or, who shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, as if it had issued out of the womb? When I made the cloud the garment thereof, and thick darkness a swaddlingband for it. And brake up for it My decreed place, and set bars and doors."
- 13. Psalm 8:3 "When I consider the heavens, the work of Thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which Thou hast ordained."

"The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament sheweth His handiwork. Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge."
"By the Word of the Lord were the heavens made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth. He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap, He layeth up the depths in storehouses. Let all the Earth fear the Lord, let all inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him. For He spake, and it was done, He commanded, and it stood fast."
"Which by His strength setteth fast the mountains, being girded with power."
"The day is Thine, the night is also Thine, Thou hast prepared the light and the sun. Thou hast set all the borders of the Earth, Thou hast made summer and winter."
"And He built His sanctuary like high palaces, like the Earth which He hath established forever."
"The heavens are Thine, the Earth also is Thine, as for the world and the fullness thereof, Thou hast founded them. The north and the south Thou has created them. Tabor and Hermon shall rejoice in Thy Name."
"Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever Thou hadst formed the Earth, and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting Thou art God."
"In His hand are the deep places of the Earth, the strength of the hills is His also. The sea is His and He made it, and His hands formed the dry land."
"Of old hast Thou laid the foundation of the Earth, and the heavens are the work of Thy hands."
"Who coverest Thyself with light as with a garment, Who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain. Who layeth the beams of His cham- bers in the waters, Who maketh the clouds His chariot, Who walketh upon the wings of the wind. Who maketh His angels spirits, His min- isters a flaming fire. Who laid the foundations of the Earth, that it should not be removed forever. Thou coveredst it with the deep as with a garment, the water stood above the mountains."
"Thy faithfulness is unto all generations, Thou hast established the Earth, and it abideth."
"Our help is in the Name of the Lord, Who made Heaven and Earth."
"To Him that by wisdom made the heavens, for His mercy endureth forever. To Him that stretched out the Earth above the waters, for His mercy endureth forever. To Him that made great lights, for His mercy endureth forever. The sun to rule by day, for His mercy en- dureth forever. The moon and stars to rule by night, for His mercy endureth forever."

- 27. Psalm 148:1-6 "Praise ye the Lord. Praise ye the Lord from the heavens. Praise Him in the heights. Praise ye Him, all His angels, praise ye Him, all his hosts. Praise ye Him, sun and moon, praise Him, all ye stars of light. Praise Him, ye heaven of heavens, and ye waters that be above the heavens. Let them praise the Name of the Lord, for He commanded, and they were created. He hath established them forever and ever, He hath made a decree which shall not pass."
- 28. Proverbs 3:19 "The Lord by wisdom hath founded the Earth, by understanding hath He established the heavens."
- 29. Proverbs 8:26-29 "While as yet He had not made the Earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world. When He prepared the heavens, I was there, when He set a compass upon the face of the depth. When He established the clouds above, when He strengthened the fountains of the deep. When He gave to the sea His decree, that the waters should not pass His commandment, when He appointed the foundations of the Earth."
- 30. Proverbs 30:4 "Who hath ascended up into Heaven, or descended? Who hath gathered the wind in His fists? Who hath bound the waters in a garment? Who hath established all the ends of the Earth? What is His Name, and what is His Son's Name, if thou canst tell?"
- 31. Ecclesiastes 3:11 "He hath made everything beautiful in His time, also He hath set the world in their heart, so that no man can find out the work that God maketh from the beginning to the end."
- 32. Ecclesiastes 11:5 "As thou knowest not what is the way of the Spirit, nor how the bones do grow in the womb of her that is with child, even so thou knowest not the works of God who maketh all."
- 33. Isaiah 40:12 "Who hath measured the waters in the hollow of His hand and meted out Heaven with His little finger, and comprehended the dust of the Earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales, and the hills in a balance?"
- 34. Isaiah 40:26 "Lift up your eyes on high, and behold Who hath created these things, that bringeth out their host by number, He calleth them all by names by the greatness of His might, for that He is strong in power, not one faileth."
- 35. Isaiah 40:28 "Hast thou not known? Hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the Earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? There is no searching of His understanding."
- 36. Isaiah 42:5 "Thus saith God the Lord, He that created the heavens and stretched them out, He that spread forth the Earth, and the people upon it, and Spirit to them that walk therein."
- 37. Isaiah 44:24 "Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, and He that formed thee from the womb, I am the Lord that maketh all things, that stretcheth forth the heavens alone, that spreadeth abroad the Earth by Myself."

38. Isaiah 45:7-12	"I form the light, and create darkness, I make peace, and create afflictions. I the Lord do all these things. Drop down ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness, let the Earth open, and let them bring forth salvation, and let righteousness spring up together, I the Lord have created it. Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker. Let the potsherd strive with the potsherds of the Earth. Shall the clay say to Him that fashioneth it, what makest thou? Or thy work, he hath no hands? Woe unto him that saith unto his Father, what begettest thou? Or to the woman, what hast thou brought forth? Thus saith the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, and His Maker, ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands, command ye me. I HAVE MADE THE EARTH, AND CREATED MAN UPON IT, I, even My hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded."
39. Isaiah 45:18	"For thus saith the Lord that created the heavens, God Himself that formed the Earth and made it, He hath established it, He created it not in vain, He formed it to be inhabited, I am the Lord, and there is none else."
40. Isaiah 48:13	"Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the Earth, and My right hand hath spanned the heavens, when I call unto them, they stand up together."
41. Isaiah 51:13	"And forgettest the Lord thy Maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundation of the Earth, and hast feared con- tinually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if He were ready to destroy? And where is the fury of the oppressor?"
42. Isaiah 66:1, 2	"Thus saith the Lord, the Heaven is My throne, and the Earth is My footstool, where is the house that ye build unto Me? And where is the place of My rest? For all those things hath Mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the Lord, but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at My Word."
43. Jeremiah 5:22	"Fear ye not Me? saith the Lord, will ye not tremble at My presence, which have placed the sand for the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it, and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail, though they roar, yet can they not pass over it?"
44. Jeremiah 10:12	"He hath made the Earth by His power, He hath established the world by His wisdom, and hath stretched out the heavens by His discretion."
45. Jeremiah 27:5	"I HAVE MADE THE EARTH, THE MAN AND THE BEAST THAT ARE UPON THE GROUND, by My great power and by My out- stretched arm, and have given it unto whom it seemed meet unto Me."
46. Jeremiah 31:35	"Thus saith the Lord, which giveth the sun for a light, by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divideth the sea when the waves thereof roar, the Lord of hosts is His Name."

- 49. Jeremiah 51:15 "He hath made the Earth by His power, He hath established the world by His wisdom, and hath stretched out the heaven by His understanding."
- 50. Jeremiah 51:16 "When He uttereth His voice, there is a multitude of waters in the heavens, and He causeth the vapors to ascend from the ends of the Earth, He maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of His treasures."
- 51. Amos 4:13 "For lo, He that formeth the mountains, and created the winds, and declareth unto man what is His thought, that maketh the morning darkness, and treadeth upon the high places of the Earth, the Lord, the God of hosts, is His Name."
- 52. Amos 5:8 "Seek Him that maketh the seven stars and Orion, and turneth the shadow of death into the morning, and maketh the day dark with night, that calleth the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the Earth, the Lord is His Name."
- 53. Amos 9:6 "It is He that buildeth His stories in the heaven, and founded His troop in the Earth, He that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the Earth. The Lord is His Name."
- 54. Jonah 1:9 "And he said unto him, I am an hebrew, and I fear the Lord, the God of heaven, which hath made the sea and the dry land."
- 55. Zechariah 12:1 "The burden of the Word of the Lord for Israel, saith the Lord, which stretcheth forth the heavens, and layeth the foundation of the Earth, and formeth the spirit of man within him."
- 56. Malachi 2:10 "Have we not all one Father? Hath not one God created us? Why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the covenant of our fathers?"
- 57. John 1:3 "All things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made."
- 58. John 1:10 "And He was in the world, and the world was made by Him, and the world knew Him not."
- 59. Acts 14:15 "And saying, Sirs, why do ye these things? We also are men of like passions with you, and preach unto you that ye should turn from these vanities unto the living God, which made Heaven, and Earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein."

60. Acts 17:24 "God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that He is Lord of Heaven and Earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands."

68. 1 Timothy 6:13	"I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and before Christ Jesus, Who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession."
69. Hebrews 1:2	"Hath in these last days spoken unto us by His Son, whom He hath appointed Heir of all things, by Whom also He made the worlds."
