

1 Pet. 1:3, "<u>Blessed be the God and Father</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,"

"God and Father" The Doctrine of the Trinity

Trinity: We believe in one God, Who is sovereign, righteous, just, eternal, love, omnipotent, omniscient, omnipresent, immutable, and truth in His essence. He exists in three persons; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. All three persons of the Godhead are co-equal and co-eternal and co-infinite. (Matthew 28:19; Acts 5:3-5; John 10:30; Psalm 22:1; Matthew 3:16; 2 Corinthians 13:14; Genesis 48:15-16, 2 Samuel 23:2-3; Genesis 1:26).

The Pre-Incarnate Christ: The Messenger of Yhwh

לאָד *mal'akh* messenger, angel

Angel, from the Greek *angelos,* was transliterated into the Vulgate as *angelus*, which then was taken to be a technical term for a special kind of "spirit being." Matt. 11:10, "For this is he of whom it is written: 'Behold, I send My <u>messenger</u> before Your face, who will prepare Your way before You.'"

άγγελος aggelos messenger, angel

Here, it isn't "angel" but "messenger" because it obviously refers to John the Baptist. Gen. 16:7, "Now the Angel of the LORD found her by a spring of water in the wilderness, by the spring on the way to Shur. ..."

Gen. 16:13, "Then she called the name of the LORD who spoke to her, You–Are–the– God–Who–Sees; for she said, 'Have I also here seen Him who sees me?'

Gen. 16:14, "Therefore the well was called Beer Lahai Roi; observe, it is between Kadesh and Bered." Gen. 16:11, "And the Angel of the LORD said to her: 'Behold, you are with child, and you shall bear a son. You shall call his name Ishmael, because the LORD has heard your affliction.'" Gen. 16:13, "Then she called the name of the LORD who spoke to her, 'You are a God who sees'; for she said, 'Have I even remained alive here after seeing Him?'" [NASB]

Gen. 21:17, "And God heard the voice of the lad. Then the angel of God called to Hagar out of heaven, and said to her, 'What ails you, Hagar? Fear not, for God has heard the voice of the lad where he is.

Gen. 21:18, " 'Arise, lift up the lad and hold him with your hand, for I will make him a great nation.' " Gen. 22:11, "But the <u>Angel of the LORD</u> called to him from heaven and said, 'Abraham, Abraham!' So he said, 'Here I am.'

Gen. 22:12, "And He said, 'Do not lay your hand on the lad, or do anything to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me.'" Gen. 22:14, "And Abraham called the name of the place, The–LORD–Will–Provide; as it is said to this day, 'In the Mount of the LORD it shall be provided.'" Gen. 22:15, "Then <u>the Angel of the LORD</u> called to Abraham a second time out of heaven,

Gen. 22:16, "and said: 'By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son—
