

1. Adamic responsibility; The result of the fall of sin. We are all guilty of Adam's sin.

All human suffering is the result of living in a corrupt universe.

2. Individual volitional responsibility.

Gal. 6:7b, "Whatsoever a man sows that shall he also reap."

3. Divine discipline.

Heb. 12:6, "For those whom the Lord loves He disciplines, and He scourges every son whom He receives.

Heb. 12:7, "It is for discipline that you endure; God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom his father does not discipline?

Heb. 12:8, "But if you are without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate children and not sons."

3. Divine discipline

2 Sam. 12:5, "So David's anger was greatly aroused against the man, and he said to Nathan, 'As the Lord lives, the man who has done this shall surely die!
2 Sam. 12:6, "'And he shall restore fourfold for the lamb, because he did this thing and because he had no pity.'"

3. Divine discipline

2 Sam. 12:11, "Thus says the LORD: 'Behold, I will raise up adversity against you from your own house; and I will take your wives before your eyes and give them to your neighbor, and he shall lie with your wives in the sight of this sun.

2 Sam. 12:12, "'For you did it secretly, but I will do this thing before all Israel, before the sun.'"

3. Divine discipline

David's fourfold restitution:

- 1. The baby died, 2 Sam. 12:14
- 2. David's son Amnon raped his sister Tamar, 2 Sam. 13:14
- 3. Absalom killed Amnon, 2 Sam. 13:28-29
- 4. Absalom revolt's against David, 2 Sam. 15:7–12 and Absalom's death, 2 Sam. 18:9
