1 John 1:8, “If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us.”

**1 John 1:9, “If we confess our sins,
He is faithful and righteous to
forgive us our sins and to cleanse
us from all unrighteousness.”**

Ex. 12:15, “ ‘Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, but on the first day you shall remove leaven from your houses; for whoever eats anything leavened from the first day until the seventh day, that person shall be cut off from Israel.’ ”

Ex. 12:19, “ ‘Seven days there shall be no leaven found in your houses; for whoever eats what is leavened, that person shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he is an alien or a native of the land.’ ”

Ex. 30:20, “when they enter the tent of meeting, they shall wash with water, that they may not die; or when they approach the altar to minister, by offering up in smoke a fire sacrifice to the LORD”

Lev. 16:20, “When he finishes atoning for the holy place, and the tent of meeting and the altar, he shall offer the live goat.

Lev. 16:21, “Then Aaron shall lay both of his hands on the head of the live goat, and confess over it all the iniquities of the sons of Israel, and all their transgressions in regard to all their sins; and he shall lay them on the head of the goat and send it away into the wilderness by the hand of a man who stands in readiness.

Lev. 16:22, “And the goat shall bear on itself all their iniquities to a solitary land; and he shall release the goat in the wilderness.”

1 Sam. 15:24, “Then Saul said to Samuel, ‘I have sinned; I have indeed transgressed the command of the LORD and your words, because I feared the people and listened to their voice.’ ”

2 Sam. 12:13, “Then David said to Nathan, ‘I have sinned against the LORD.’ And Nathan said to David, ‘The LORD also has taken away your sin; you shall not die.’ ”

2 Sam. 24:10, “Now David’s heart troubled him after he had numbered the people. So David said to the LORD, ‘I have sinned greatly in what I have done. But now, O LORD, please take away the iniquity of Thy servant, for I have acted very foolishly.’ ”

2 Sam. 24:17, “Then David spoke to the LORD when he saw the angel who was striking down the people, and said, ‘Behold, it is I who have sinned, and it is I who have done wrong; but these sheep, what have they done? Please let Thy hand be against me and against my father’s house.’ ”

2 Chron. 29:5, “Then he said to them,
‘Listen to me, O Levites. Consecrate
yourselves now, and consecrate the house
of the LORD, the God of your fathers, and
carry the uncleanness out from the holy
place.

2 Chron. 29:6, “ ‘For our fathers have been
unfaithful and have done evil in the sight of
the LORD our God, and have forsaken Him
and turned their faces away from the
dwelling place of the LORD, and have
turned their backs.’ ”

Ezra 9:4, “Then everyone who trembled at the words of the God of Israel on account of the unfaithfulness of the exiles gathered to me, and I sat appalled until the evening offering.

Ezra 9:5, “But at the evening offering I arose from my humiliation, even with my garment and my robe torn, and I fell on my knees and stretched out my hands to the LORD my God;”

Ezra 9:6, “and I said, ‘O my God, I am ashamed and embarrassed to lift up my face to Thee, my God, for our iniquities have risen above our heads, and our guilt has grown even to the heavens.

Ezra 9:7, “ ‘Since the days of our fathers to this day we have been in great guilt, and on account of our iniquities we, our kings and our priests have been given into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to plunder and to open shame, as it is this day.’ ”

Ezra 10:1, “Now while Ezra was praying and making confession, weeping and prostrating himself before the house of God, a very large assembly, men, women, and children, gathered to him from Israel; for the people wept bitterly.”

Neh. 1:6, “let Thine ear now be attentive and Thine eyes open to hear the prayer of Thy servant which I am praying before Thee now, day and night, on behalf of the sons of Israel Thy servants, confessing the sins of the sons of Israel which we have sinned against Thee; I and my father's house have sinned.

Neh. 1:7, “We have acted very corruptly against Thee and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the ordinances which Thou didst command Thy servant Moses.”

Neh. 9:1, “Now on the twenty-fourth day of this month the sons of Israel assembled with fasting, in sackcloth, and with dirt upon them.

Neh. 9:2, “And the descendants of Israel separated themselves from all foreigners, and stood and confessed their sins and the iniquities of their fathers.”

Neh. 9:3, “While they stood in their place, they read from the book of the law of the LORD their God for a fourth of the day; and for another fourth they confessed and worshiped the LORD their God.”

Job 7:20, “Have I sinned? What have I done to Thee, O watcher of men? Why hast Thou set me as Thy target, so that I am a burden to myself?”

Job 9:20, “Though I am righteous, my mouth will condemn me; Though I am guiltless, He will declare me guilty.”

Job 13:23, “How many are my iniquities and sins? Make known to me my rebellion and my sin.”

**Psa. 32:5, “I acknowledged my sin to
Thee, and my iniquity I did not hide; I
said, ‘I will confess my transgressions
to the LORD’; and Thou didst forgive
the guilt of my sin. Selah.”**

Psa. 38:1, “O LORD, rebuke me not in Thy wrath; and chasten me not in Thy burning anger.

Psa. 38:2, “For Thine arrows have sunk deep into me, and Thy hand has pressed down on me.”

Psa. 38:3, “There is no soundness in my flesh because of Thine indignation; There is no health in my bones because of my sin.

Psa. 38:4, “For my iniquities are gone over my head; as a heavy burden they weigh too much for me.”

**Psa. 41:4, “As for me, I said, ‘O LORD,
be gracious to me; Heal my soul, for I
have sinned against Thee.’ ”**

Psa. 51:2, “Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

Psa. 51:3, “For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.”

Psa. 51:4, “Against Thee, Thee only, I have sinned, and done what is evil in Thy sight, so that Thou art justified when Thou dost speak, and blameless when Thou dost judge.

Isa. 6:5, “Then I said, ‘Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.’ ”

Isa. 59:12, “For our transgressions are multiplied before Thee, and our sins testify against us; For our transgressions are with us, and we know our iniquities:

Isa. 59:13, “Transgressing and denying the LORD, and turning away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving in and uttering from the heart lying words.”

**Isa. 59:14, “And justice is turned back,
and righteousness stands far away;
For truth has stumbled in the street,
and uprightness cannot enter.**

**Isa. 59:15, “Yes, truth is lacking; And
he who turns aside from evil makes
himself a prey. Now the LORD saw,
and it was displeasing in His sight that
there was no justice.”**

Dan. 9:20, “Now while I was speaking and praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the LORD my God in behalf of the holy mountain of my God,”

Luke 5:8, “But when Simon Peter saw that, he fell down at Jesus’ feet, saying, ‘Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!’ ”

Luke 15:18, “I will get up and go to my father, and will say to him, ‘Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in your sight;

Luke 15:19, “ ‘I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me as one of your hired men.’ ”

Luke 15:20, “And he got up and came to his father. But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him, and felt compassion for him, and ran and embraced him, and kissed him.

Luke 15:21, “And the son said to him, ‘Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight; I am no longer worthy to be called your son.’ ”

John 13:6, “And so He came to Simon Peter. He said to Him, ‘Lord, do You wash my feet?’”

John 13:7, “Jesus answered and said to him, ‘What I do you do not realize now, but you shall understand hereafter.’ ”

John 13:8, “Peter said to Him, ‘Never shall You wash my feet!’ Jesus answered him, ‘If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.’”

John 13:9, “Simon Peter said to Him, ‘Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head.’”

John 13:10, “Jesus said to him, ‘He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you.’ ”

1 Cor. 5:6, “Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump of dough?”

1 Cor. 5:7, “Clean out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.’ ”

1 Cor. 5:8, “Let us therefore celebrate the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.”

1 Cor. 11:28, “But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

1 Cor. 11:29, “For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself, if he does not judge the body rightly.”

1 Cor. 11:30, “For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and a number sleep.

1 Cor. 11:31, “But if we judged ourselves rightly, we should not be judged.

1 Cor. 11:32, “But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord in order that we may not be condemned along with the world.”

James 4:8, “Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.”

Rev. 3:19, “Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; be zealous therefore, and repent.

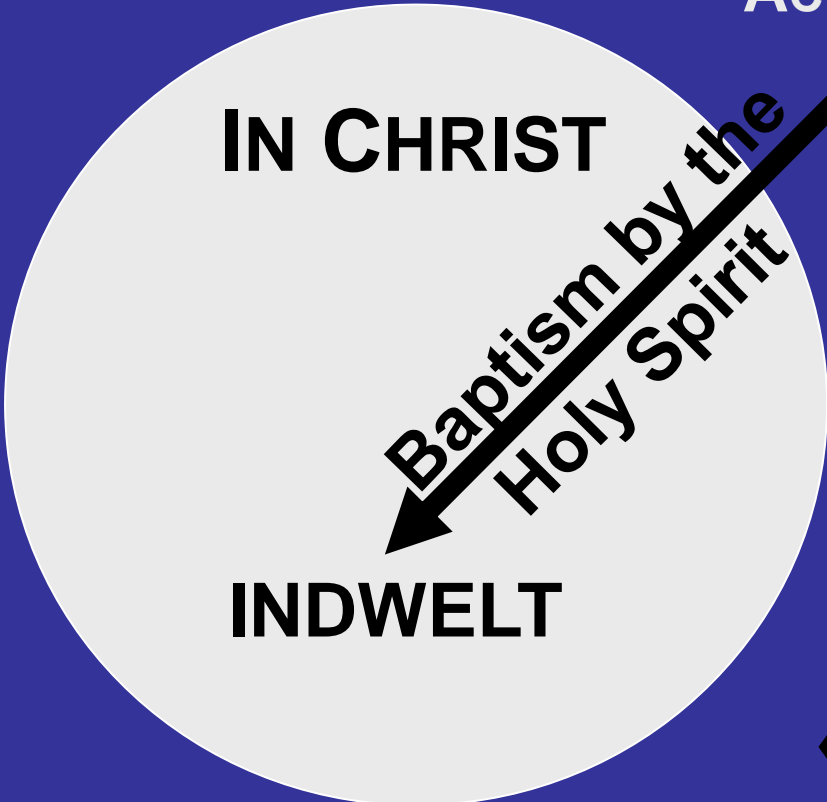

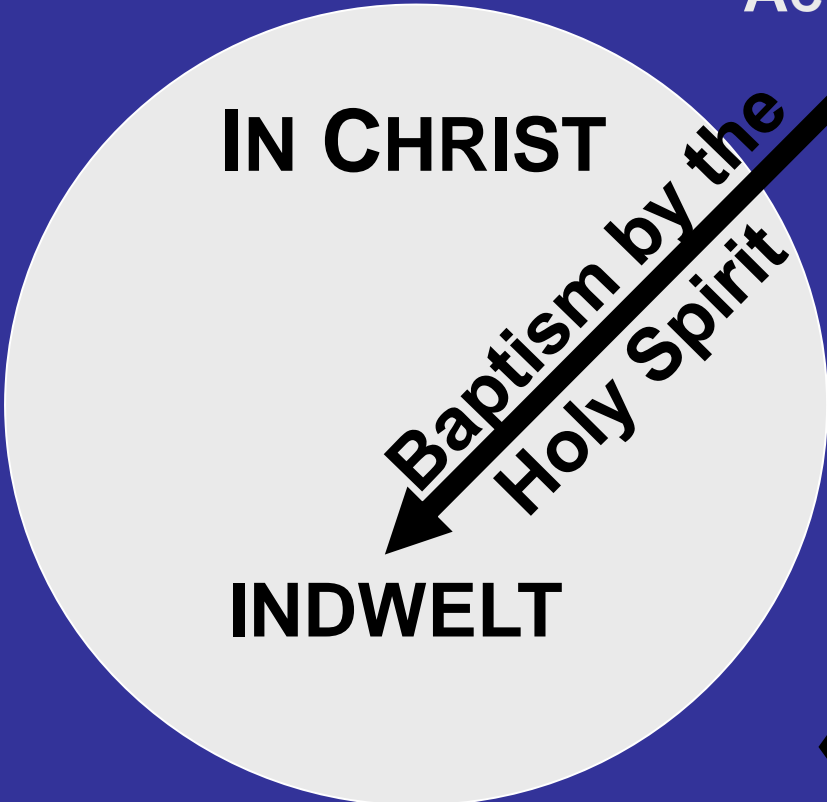

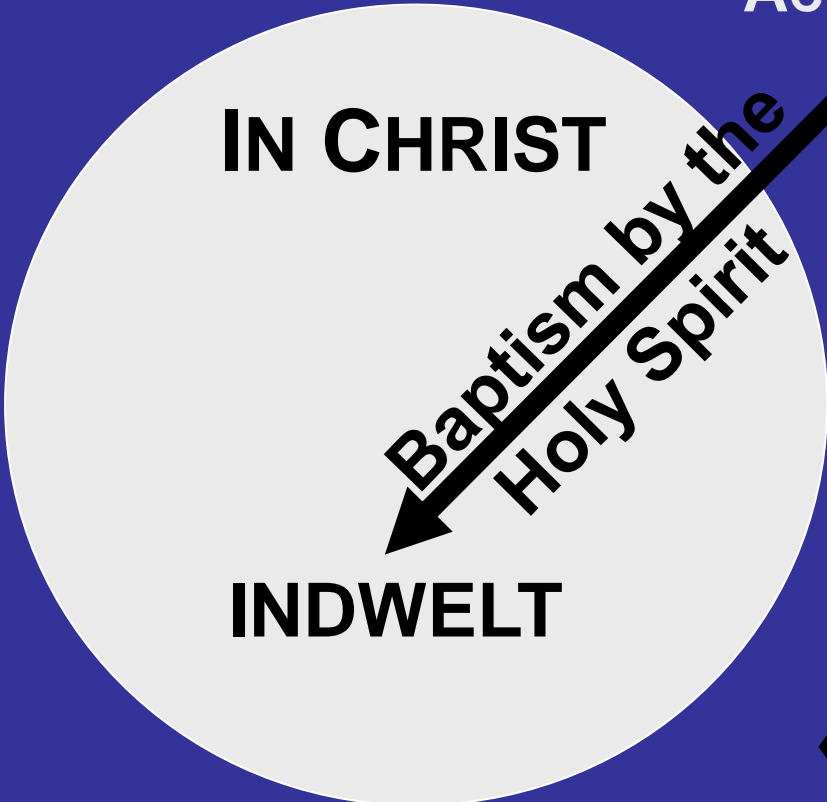
