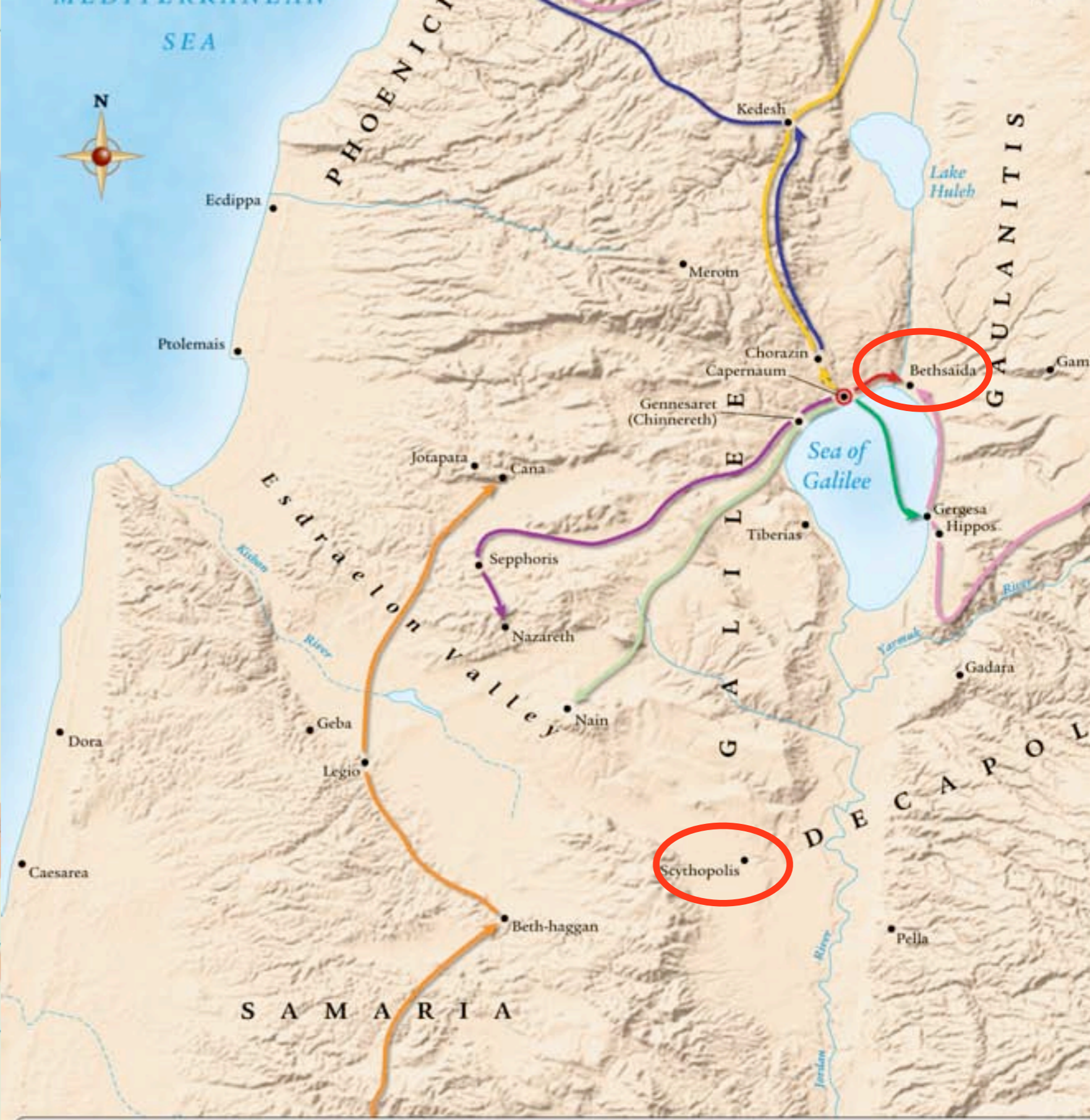
John 1:35, “Again, the next day, John stood with two of his disciples.”

John 1:40, “One of the two who heard John speak, and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother.”



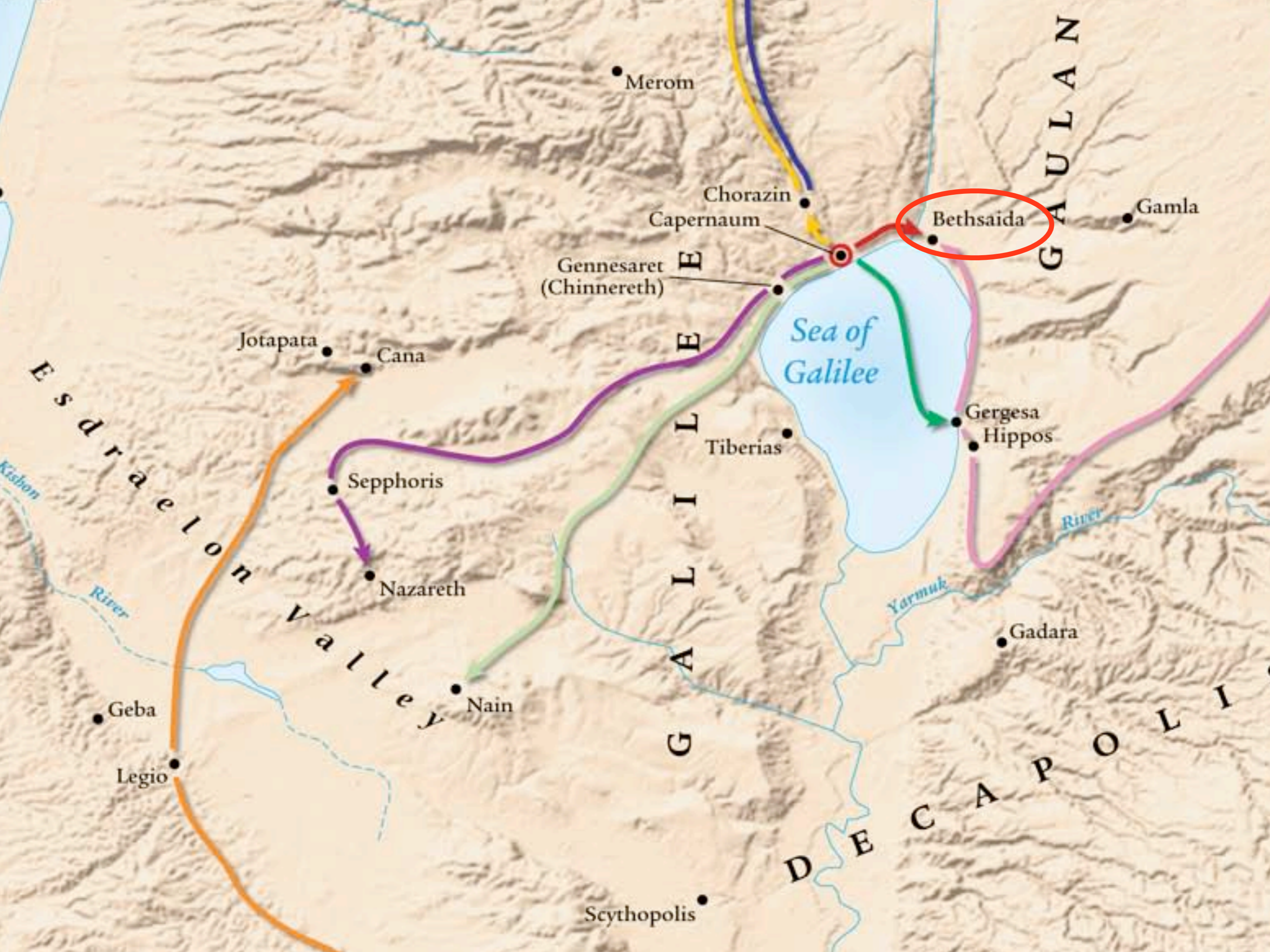
Possible site of burial of John the Baptist.

- Jesus journeys into the regions of Tyre and Sidon (Matthew 15:21-28)

Matt. 4:19, “Then He said to them, ‘Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.’

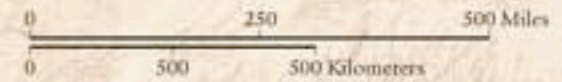
Matt. 4:20, “They immediately left their nets and followed Him.”

THE JEWISH DIASPORA AT PENTECOST

- City with a Jewish population at the time of Pentecost
- Region attested at Pentecost (*Acts 2:9ff*)
- Other regions of Jewish diaspora



Matt. 10:2, “Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother;

Matt. 10:3, “Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;

Matt. 10:4, “Simon the Cananite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him.

Mark 3:16–19; Luke 6:14–16;

Acts 1:13, “And when they had entered, they went up into the upper room where they were staying: Peter, James, John, and Andrew; Philip and Thomas; Bartholomew and Matthew; James the son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot; and Judas the son of James.”
