John 1:35, "Again, the next day, John stood with two of his disciples."

John 1:40, "One of the two who heard John speak, and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother."



Matt. 10:2, "Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; <u>James</u> the son of Zebedee, and <u>John</u> his brother;

Matt. 10:3, "Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;

Matt. 10:4, "Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him."

Mark 3:16-19; Luke 6:14-16;

Acts 1:13, "And when they had entered, they went up into the upper room where they were staying: Peter, James, John, and Andrew; Philip and Thomas; <u>Bartholomew</u> and Matthew; James the son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot; and Judas the son of James."

John 19:25, "Now there stood by the cross of Jesus (1) His mother, and (2) His mother's sister, (3) Mary the wife of Clopas, and (4) Mary Magdalene."

Matt. 27:56, "among whom were (4) Mary Magdalene, (3) Mary the mother of James and Joses, and (2?) the mother of Zebedee's sons."

Mark 15:40, "There were also women looking on from afar, among whom were (4) Mary Magdalene, (3) Mary the mother of James the Less and of Joses, and (2?) Salome,"





Matt. 17:1, "Now after six days Jesus took Peter, <u>James, and John</u> his brother, led them up on a high mountain by themselves;

Matt. 17:2, "and He was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light.

Matt. 17:3, "And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him.

Matt. 17:4, "Then Peter answered and said to Jesus, 'Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, let us make here three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.'

Matt. 17:5, "While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, 'This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!'"

Luke 9:54, "And when His disciples <u>James and John</u> saw this, they said, 'Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them, just as Elijah did?'

Luke 9:55, "But He turned and rebuked them, and said, 'You do not know what manner of spirit you are of.

Luke 9:56, "'For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives but to save them.' And they went to another village."

Matt. 13:55, "Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary?

And His brothers <u>James</u>, Joses, Simon, and Judas?"

- 1 Cor. 15:4, "and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,
- 1 Cor. 15:5, "and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve.
- 1 Cor. 15:6, "After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep.
- 1 Cor. 15:7, "After that He was seen by <u>James</u>, then by all the apostles."

Gal. 1:18, "Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and remained with him fifteen days.

Gal. 1:19, "But I saw none of the other apostles except <u>James</u>, the <u>Lord's brother</u>."
