Acts as a Transition and Overview of Things to Come Acts 13; Matthew 16:15–18; John 21:15–17



Matt. 16:15, "He said to them, 'But who do you say that I am?'

Matt. 16:16, "Simon Peter answered and said, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.'

Matt. 16:17, "Jesus answered and said to him, 'Blessed are you, Simon Bar-jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

Matt. 16:18, " 'And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock <u>I will build My church</u>, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it."

John 21:15, "So when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, 'Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me more than these?'

John 21:16, "<u>He</u> said to him again a second time, 'Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?' He said to Him, 'Yes, Lord; You know that I love You.' <u>He</u> said to him, '<u>Tend My sheep</u>.'

John 21:17, "<u>He</u> said to him the third time, 'Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?' Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, 'Do you love Me?' And he said to Him, 'Lord, You know all things; You know

that I love You.'

Jesus said to him, 'Feed My sheep.' "

- III. God expands the church to the end of the earth. (13:1–28:31)


- I. God, through the Holy Spirit, authenticates, empowers, and directs the apostles' witness in Jerusalem. (1:1–6:7)
 - A. God gives birth to a new spiritual entity, the Church. (1:1–2:47)

B. The Lord expands the Church in Jerusalem. (3:1–6:7)


Healings; opposition; prayer; service

- II. God expands the witness of the Church into Judea and Samaria. (Acts 6:8–9:31)
 - A. God allows persecution to drive the Church out of Jerusalem. (Acts 6:8–8:3)
 - B. God sends Philip out to the Samaritans and demonstrates their unity with the work in Jerusalem by a similar outpouring of the Holy Spirit by the hands of Peter and John. (Acts 8:4–40)
 - C. God saves Saul which prepares the way for the Gentiles. (Acts 9:1–31)
 - D. God directs Peter to take the gospel to the Gentiles, who become equal members in the body of Christ. (Acts 10:1–11:30)
 - E. God allows persecution to develop under Herod Agrippa I, disciplines him through death, and moves Paul and Barnabas to Antioch, the new center for the expansion of Christianity. (Acts 12:1–25)



III. God expands the Church to the end of the earth. (13:1–28:31)

- A. God expands the Church into Asia Minor. (Acts 12:25–18:22)
 1st two missionary journeys
- B. God expands the Church to Rome: Paul's third missionary journey and the trip to Rome. (Acts 18:23–28:31)


