“to forget, neglect, overlook”

Anthropomorphism [Greek (*anthropos*), man; (*morphe*), form]

Language of accommodation that ascribes to God human physical characteristics which He does not actually possess to explain His essence, policy, acts, and decisions in terms of human anatomy. Examples include: the face of God (Ps. 11:7), the eyes of God (Ps 5:5), the ears of God (Ps. 130:2), the arms of God (Ex. 15:16; Deut. 33:27).

διακονέω *diakonéō*; aor. act. part. “to minister, to serve, perhaps to offer financial help (BBC). These two ptcp should be understood as causal –

AND ARE CONTINUING TO DO SO.**
