**κατανοέω (*katanoeō*); Pres act subj, 1P; hortatory subj; we must consider, or we should consider; “give careful thought to something, contemplate, brainstorm”**

**παροξυσμός (*paroxysmos*), 2× in New Testament; “to rouse to activity, to provoke action, sharp disagreement, ardent incitement; to stir to action”**
