
13. Bear one another's burdens (Gal 6:2; thus fulfill the law of Christ = love one another)

- v. 22, Wives to you own husbands, as the Church to Christ (v. 25)
- 6:1, Children to parents
- 6:5, Servants (slaves) to masters

1 Pet. 5:5, "Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for 'God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble'."

17. Think about one another to stir up to love and good deeds.

Heb. 10:24, "And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works" [application of doctrine in thought, word, actions]

18. Confess to one another, i.e., apologize when you wrong someone, not public self-flagellation.
