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
Heb. 11:21, "By faith Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, and worshiped, leaning on the top of his staff."

CWSD: A verb meaning "to judge, to govern." This word, though often translated as "judge," is much more inclusive than the modern concept of judging and encompasses all the facets and functions of government: executive, legislative, and judicial.

HALOT: "to rule, control"

Judg. 13:2, "Now there was a certain man from Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; and his wife was barren and had no children."




1. Dan conquest of Laish and establishing idolatry.


