- 5. Rameses date based on the Ebers calendar: 1279 BC**

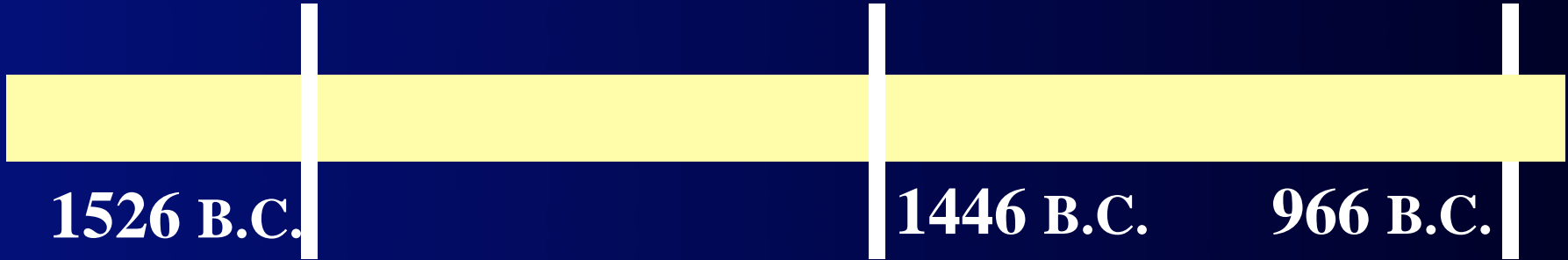

overthrew **נָעַר** (*nā^car*) II, shake, shake out

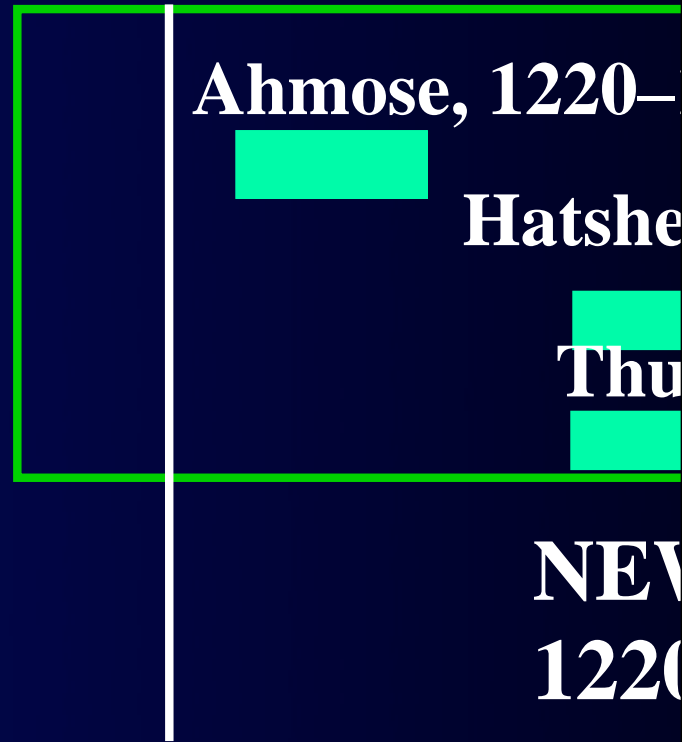
