Heb. 11:33, "who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions"

καταγωνίζομαι katagonizomai "to defeat, conquer"

Joshua, Barak, Gideon, Jephthah, David. Certainly David completes the conquest and expansion of the land which Joshua began.

Heb. 11:33, "who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions"

2 Sam. 8:15, "So David reigned over all Israel; and David administered judgment and justice to all his people." 1 Kings 3:28, "And all Israel heard of the judgment which the king had rendered; and they feared the king, for they saw that the wisdom of God was in him to administer justice."

2 Chron. 19:6, "and said to the judges, 'Take heed to what you are doing, for you do not judge for man but for the LORD, who is with you in the judgment.
2 Chron. 19:7, " 'Now therefore, let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take care and do it, for there is no iniquity with the LORD our God, no partiality, nor taking of bribes.' "

Heb. 11:33, "who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions"

ἐπιτυγχάνω epitunchano "to be successful in achieving or gaining what one seeks, obtain, attain to, reach" Dan. 6:21, "Then Daniel said to the king, 'O king, live forever!

Dan. 6:22, "'My God sent His angel and shut the lions' mouths, so that they have not hurt me, because I was found innocent before Him; and also, O king, I have done no wrong before you.'" 1 Sam. 17:34, "But David said to Saul, 'Your servant used to keep his father's sheep, and when a lion or a bear came and took a lamb out of the flock,

1 Sam. 17:35, "'I went out after it and struck it, and delivered the lamb from its mouth; and when it arose against me, I caught it by its beard, and struck and killed it.

1 Sam. 17:36, "'Your servant has killed both lion and bear; and this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, seeing he has defied the armies of the living God.'

1 Sam. 17:37, "Moreover David said, 'The LORD, who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, He will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine.' And Saul said to David, 'Go, and the LORD be with you!' " Judg. 14:6, "And the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and he tore the lion apart as one would have torn apart a young goat, though he had nothing in his hand. But he did not tell his father or his mother what he had done."

The Nazirite Vow

Num. 6:2, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When either a man or woman consecrates an offering to take the vow of a Nazirite, to separate himself to the LORD,

Num. 6:3, " 'he shall separate himself from wine and similar drink; he shall drink neither vinegar made from wine nor vinegar made from similar drink; neither shall he drink any grape juice, nor eat fresh grapes or raisins.

Num. 6:4, " 'All the days of his separation he shall eat nothing that is produced by the grapevine, from seed to skin.' "

The Nazirite Vow

Num. 6:5, "All the days of the vow of his separation no razor shall come upon his head; until the days are fulfilled for which he separated himself to the LORD, he shall be holy. Then he shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow.

Num. 6:6, "All the days that he separates himself to the LORD he shall not go near a dead body.

Num. 6:7, "He shall not make himself unclean even for his father or his mother, for his brother or his sister, when they die, because his separation to God is on his head."
