


The VOW:


To his wife:

"This island is the front line that defends our mainland, and I am going to die here."








Mt. Suribachi fortress firing at Marines







2 Chronicles 29:21, "And they brought seven bulls, seven rams, seven lambs, and seven male goats for a sin offering for the kingdom, for the sanctuary, and for Judah. Then he commanded the priests, the sons of Aaron, to offer them on the altar of the LORD."

2 Chronicles 29:32, "The number of the burnt offerings which the assembly brought was 70 bulls, 100 rams, and 200 lambs; all these were for a burnt offering to the Lord.

2 Chronicles 29:33, "The consecrated things were 600 bulls and 3,000 sheep."

2 Chronicles 29:34, "But the priests were too few, so that they were unable to skin all the burnt offerings; therefore their brothers the Levites helped them until the work was completed and until the other priests had consecrated themselves. For the Levites were more conscientious to consecrate themselves than the priests."

2 Chronicles 30:24, "For Hezekiah king of Judah gave to the assembly a thousand bulls and seven thousand sheep, and the leaders gave to the assembly a thousand bulls and ten thousand sheep; and a great number of priests sanctified themselves."

John 8:31, "Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, 'If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed.

John 8:32, "'And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.'"

John 8:33, "They answered Him, 'We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How can You say, "You will be made free"?'

John 8:34, "Jesus answered them, 'Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin.' "

John 8:35, "And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever.

John 8:36, "Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed."
