


Isa. 61:1, "The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;" Matt. 12:24, "Now when the Pharisees heard it they said, 'This fellow does not cast out demons except by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons.'

Matt. 12:25, "But Jesus knew their thoughts, and said to them: 'Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand.

Matt. 12:26, " 'If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then will his kingdom stand?' " Matt. 12:27, " 'And if I cast out demons by Beelzebub, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore they shall be your judges.

Matt. 12:28, "'But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.'" Isa. 53:4, "Surely He has borne our <u>griefs</u> and carried our <u>sorrows</u>; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

Isa. 53:5, "But He was wounded for our <u>transgressions</u>, He was bruised for our <u>iniquities</u>; the chastisement for our <u>peace</u> was upon Him, and by His stripes we are <u>healed</u>."
