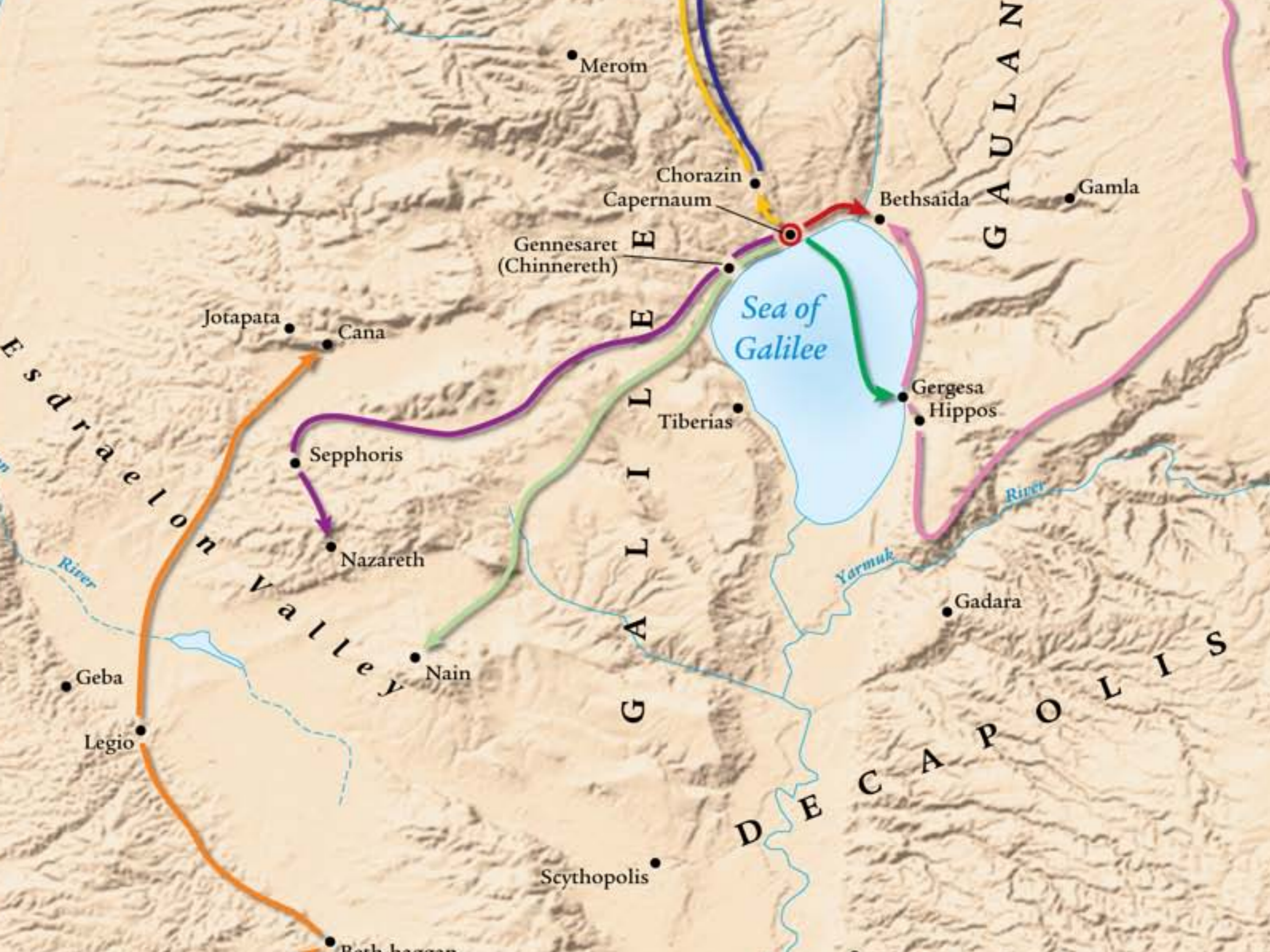
The Power of Jesus;

Matthew 9:18–26

The Miracles of Restoration (Matt. 9:18–34)

- 1. Jesus restores health to the hemorrhaging woman and life to Jairus' daughter.**
- 2. Jesus restores sight to two blind men.**
- 3. Jesus restores speech to a demon-possessed man.**





Matt. 9:18, “While He spoke these things to them, behold, a ruler came and worshiped Him, saying, ‘My daughter has just died, but come and lay Your hand on her and she will live.’

Matt. 9:19, “So Jesus arose and followed him, and so did His disciples.”

Mark 5:22, “And behold, one of the rulers of the synagogue came, Jairus by name. And when he saw Him, he fell at His feet

Mark 5:23, “and begged Him earnestly, saying, ‘My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live.’

Mark 5:24, “So Jesus went with him, and a great multitude followed Him and thronged Him.”

Luke 8:41, “And behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue. And he fell down at Jesus’ feet and begged Him to come to his house,

Luke 8:42, “for he had an only daughter about twelve years of age, and she was dying. But as He went, the multitudes thronged Him.”
