<u>Matt. 22:35,</u> "Then one of them, <u>a lawyer,</u> [*nomikos–expert in the Torah*] asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying,

Matt. 22:36, "'Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?'"

<u>Mark 12:30,</u> "'And you shall <u>love</u> the LORD your God with all your <u>heart</u>, with all your <u>soul</u>, with all your <u>mind</u>, and with all your <u>strength</u>.' This is the first commandment."

1. God is Love, 1 John 4:8, 16

<u>1 John 4:8,</u> "He who does not love does not know God, for <u>God is love</u>."

<u>1 John 4:16</u>, "And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. <u>God is love</u>, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him."

2. God initiates love toward the human race.

<u>1 John 4:19, "We love [Him] because He first loved us."</u>

3. This makes God ~ the male as the initiator.

The human race ~ the female as the responder.

4. Human love is part of the image of God in all of us, and finds its archetype or pattern in God's love.

5. Therefore, we must understand Divine Love if we are going to understand Love.
