


ἐξουσία *exousia* Noun nom fem sing right, power, <u>authority</u>, ruling power, a bearer of authority Dan. 7:14, "Then to Him [Son of Man] was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed." <u>Rev. 3:21,</u> "To him who overcomes I [Jesus] will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne."


# No Literal, Earthly Kingdom 1,000 is merely a symbolic number

# Premillennialism Already, but not yet



### Inaugurated, and progressively coming in

Eph. 1:22, "And He [God the Father] put all things under His [God the Son] feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church,"

Eph. 4:15, "but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him <u>who is the</u> <u>head—Christ—</u>"

Eph. 5:23, "For the husband is head of the wife, as also <u>Christ is head of the church;</u> and He is the Savior of the body."

<u>Col. 1:18</u>, "And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence."

Col. 2:10, "and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power."

<u>Col. 2:19</u>, "and not holding fast to the Head, from whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase that is from God."

### John 17:17, "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

John 17:18, "As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world.

John 17:19, "And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth."
