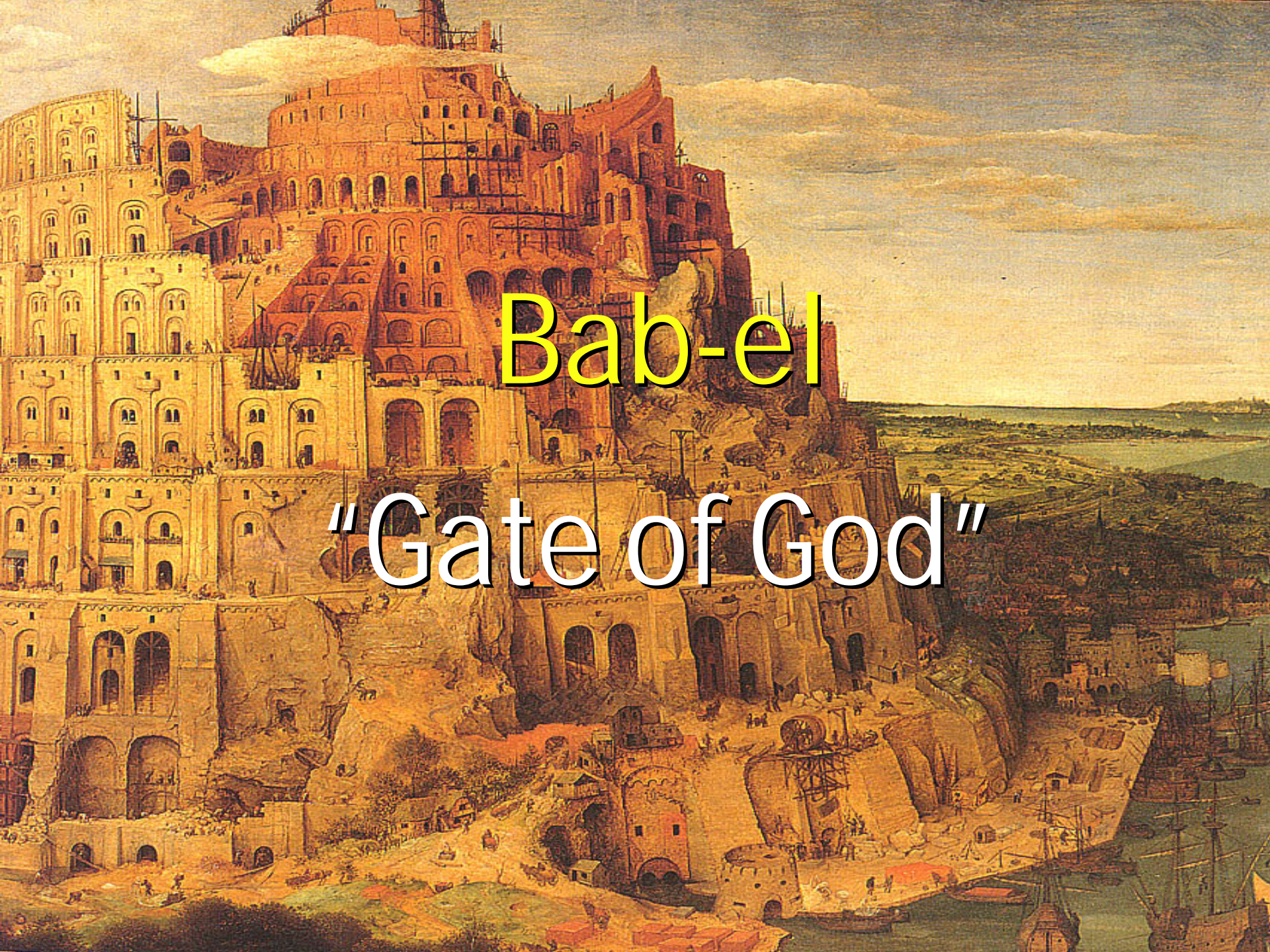

Early: Pseudepigrapha: *The Life of Adam and Eve*, ca. AD 2<sup>nd</sup> century; *Slavonic Enoch*, ca. AD 2<sup>nd</sup> century

Origen (AD 185–254) 1<sup>st</sup> to tie to Ezek 28

Tertullian (AD 160–225)

Cyprian (AD 200–258); Gregory Thaumaturgus, Gregory Nazianzen; Gregory of Nyssa; Jerome, the majority from Augustine to Gregory the Great (AD 590–604).

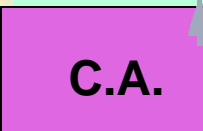

**Isaiah 14:12, “Look how you have fallen from the sky, O shining one, son of the dawn! You’ve been cut down to the ground, O conqueror of the nations!**

**Isaiah 14:13, “You said to yourself, ‘I will climb up to the sky. Above the stars of El; I will set up my throne. I will rule on the mountain of assembly on the remoteness of Zaphon.**

**Isaiah 14:14, “‘I will climb up to the tops of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High!’**

**Isaiah 14:15, “But you were brought down to Sheol, to the remote slopes of the pit.”**

**Isa 14:12, “How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations!**

**Isa 14:13, “For you have said in your heart: ‘I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north;’”**

**Job 38:7, “When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?”**

**Isa 14:14, “I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.”**

**Gen 3:4, “Then the serpent said to the woman,  
‘You will not surely die.**

**Gen 3:5, “For God knows that in the day you  
eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will  
be like God, knowing good and evil.’”**
