


**Revelation 4:3, “And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and *there was* a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald.”**



**Revelation 4:4, “Around the throne  
twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones  
I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed  
in white robes; and they had crowns of  
gold on their heads.”**

Revelation 5:9, “And they sang a new song, saying: ‘You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have redeemed us [NASB: *men*] to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,”

**Revelation 5:9, “And they [the two groups mentioned] sang a new song, saying:**

**[First group, the 24 elders]**

**“You [the Lamb] are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have redeemed **us** to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,**

**[Second Group: the Living Creatures]**

**Revelation 5:10, “And have made **them** kings and priests to our God; and You shall reign on the earth.”**





**Revelation 4:5, “And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices.**


**Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.”**

**Revelation 4:6, “Before the throne *there was a sea of glass, like crystal.* And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back.”**



**Revelation 4:7, “The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle.”**

**Revelation 4:8, “*The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying:*

**Revelation 4:9, “Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever,**

**Revelation 4:10, “the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying:**

**Revelation 4:11, “‘You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created.’”**

**Colossians 1:16, “For **by Him** all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.**

**Colossians 1:17, “And He is before all things, and **in [by] Him** all things consist.”**

**Revelation 3:21, “To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.”**

**Revelation 5:1, “And I saw in the right *hand* of Him who sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with seven seals.”**




**Revelation 5:2, “Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, ‘Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?’**

**Revelation 5:3, “And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it.”**




**Revelation 5:4, “So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it.”**



**Revelation 5:5, “But one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals.””**





**Revelation 5:6, “And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.”**

**Revelation 5:7, “Then He came and took the scroll out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne.”**



**Revelation 5:8, “Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.”**

**Revelation 5:9, “And they sang a new song, saying:**

**24 sing** “You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,”

**Revelation 5:10**

**Living Creatures sing antiphonally:** “And has made you kings and priests to our God; and you shall reign on the earth.”

**Revelation 5:11, “Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders; and the number of them was myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands,”**

**Revelation 5:12, “saying with a loud voice,  
‘Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive  
power and riches and wisdom and might and  
honor and glory and blessing.’”**
