


SIXTH SEAL JUDGMENT

Physical Disturbances



Great Earthquake Sun, black as sackcloth Moon, like blood Stars, fell to earth Sky, split like a scroll Mountains & Islands, moved out of their place Rev. 6:12, "I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and behold, there was a great earthquake;
