

First 21 Months of Tribulation

Rev. 6:16, "and they said to the mountains and to the rocks, 'Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb;

Rev. 6:17, "for the great day of their wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

1st question: Who can stand, who can survive?

Answer: The 144,000 sealed, the martyrs

2nd question: How can a loving God pour out such wrath on His creatures or on believers?

God's character

[His righteousness, justice, love, in sum His integrity, His goodness]

is demonstrated most fully in a universe where evil is allowed to continue for a time (which entails injustice and suffering)

in order for God to fully judge evil and end suffering.

God's character

[His righteousness, justice, love, in sum His integrity, His goodness]

God is in control

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in order for God to fully judge evil and end suffering.

God has a purpose, though we may not fully comprehend it.

- 1. The nature of God;
- 2. The nature of evil and suffering;
- 3. The nature of justice;
- 4. The divine purpose for history.

Rev. 7:3, "saying, 'Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees until we have sealed the bond-servants of our God on their foreheads'."

"to seal, the seal of a signet ring, a mark of ownership; some indicated the family, it was used to sign legal documents in much the same way that we do today." Rev. 7:4, "And I heard the number of those who were sealed, one hundred and forty-four thousand sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel:"






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




THE LINE OF THE SEED

Deuteronomy 30:2, "and you return to the LORD your God and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, with all your heart and with all your soul,

Deuteronomy 30:3, "that the LORD your God will bring you back from captivity, and have compassion on you, and gather you again from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you."
