

The Titles of Satan

1. Satan, “adversary” 27× in the Old Testament; (cf., Matt 4:10)

Job 1:6, “Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them.”

2. The devil, “slanderer”

Matt. 4:1, “Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.”

3. The prince and the power of the air

Eph. 2:2, “in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience,”

4. The god of this age

2 Cor. 4:4, “whose minds the god of this age [αἰωνος, aionos] has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.”

5. The ruler of this world

John 12:31, “Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out.”

6. *Helel ben shahar*, “The shining one, son of the dawn”

**Is. 14:12, “How you have fallen from heaven,
O star of the morning, son of the dawn!
[Lucifer] You have been cut down to the
earth, you who have weakened the
nations!”**

7. The great red dragon

Rev. 12:9, “So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.”

8. The wicked one

Matt. 13:19, “When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside.”

9. The tempter, 1 Thess 3:5

Matt. 4:3, “Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, ‘If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.’”

10. The accuser

Rev. 12:10, “Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, ‘Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down.’”

**Rev. 13:1, "And I [vs the dragon
(NU)]**

stood on the sand of the sea.

**Then I saw a beast coming up out
of the sea, having ten horns and
seven heads, and on his horns
were ten diadems, and on his
heads were blasphemous names."**

Dan. 7:2, “Daniel spoke, saying, ‘I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea.

Dan. 7:3, “‘And four great beasts came up from the sea, each different from the other.’”

**Rev. 17:1, "Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying, 'Come here, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters,
Rev. 17:2, "with whom the kings of the earth committed acts of immorality, and those who dwell on the earth were made drunk with the wine of her immorality.'"**

Rev. 17:3, "And he carried me away in the Spirit into a wilderness; and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast, full of blasphemous names, having seven heads and ten horns."

**Rev. 17:15, “And he said to me,
‘The waters which you saw where
the harlot sits, are peoples and
multitudes and nations and
tongues.’”**

θηρίον *thērion* a wild beast, wild animal.
