


2 Th. 2:4, "who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God."

Dan. 11:44, "But news from the east and the north shall trouble him; therefore he shall go out with great fury to destroy and annihilate many.



Rev. 16:15, "'Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.'


Rev. 16:16, "And they gathered them together to the place called in Hebrew, Armageddon."






Mt Tabor

Mt Gilboa


