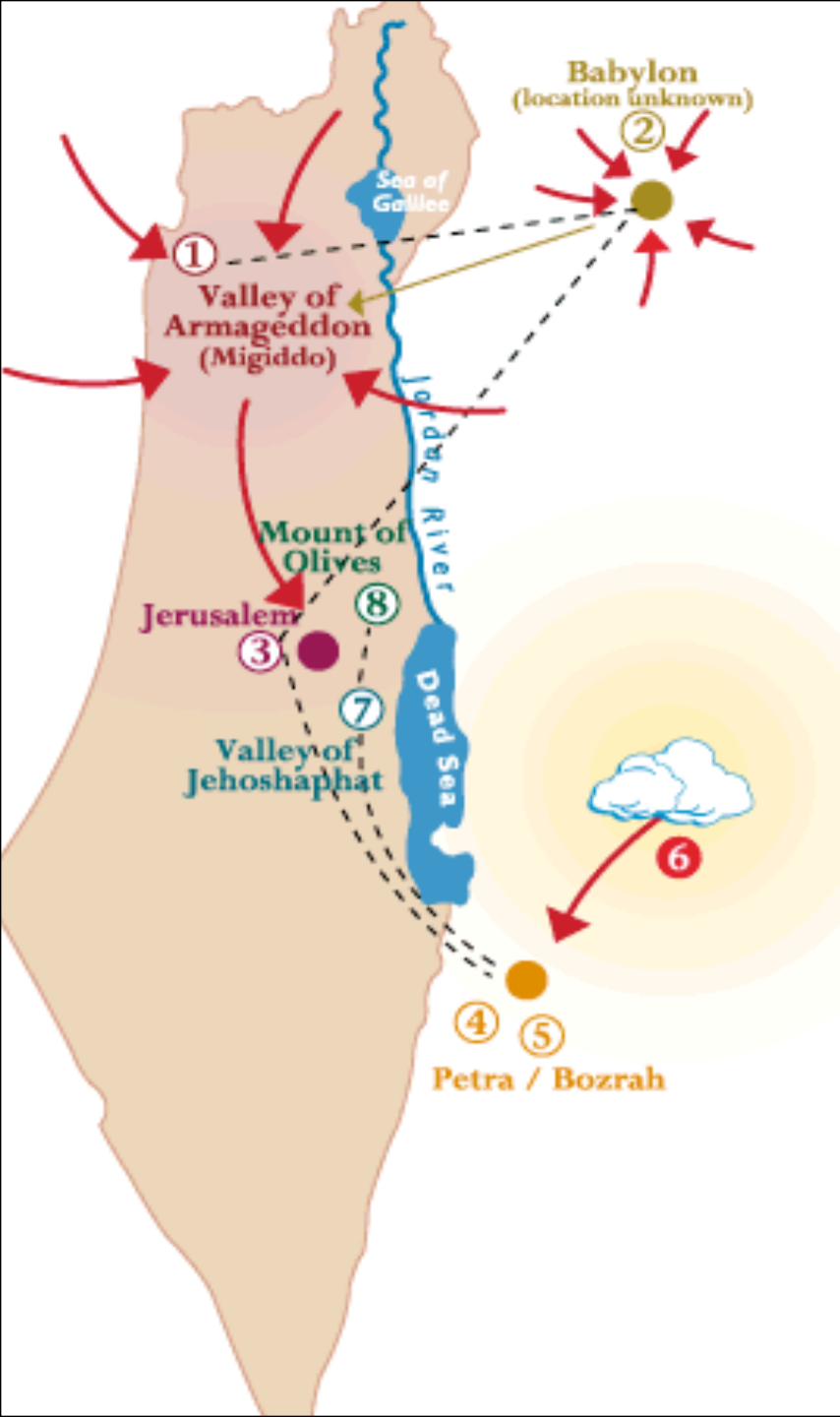

**Matt. 23:37, “O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!
Matt. 23:38, “See! Your house is left to you desolate;”**

Deut. 4:30, "When you are in distress, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, when you turn to the LORD your God and obey His voice

Deut. 4:31, "(for the LORD your God is a merciful God), He will not forsake you nor destroy you, nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He swore to them."

Deut. 30:1, "Now it shall come to pass, when all these things come upon you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and you call them to mind among all the nations where the LORD your God drives you,

Deut. 30:2, "and you return to the LORD your God and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, with all your heart and with all your soul,"

Deut. 30:3, "that the LORD your God will bring you back from captivity, and have compassion on you, and gather you again from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you

Deut. 30:4, "If any of you are driven out to the farthest parts under heaven, from there the LORD your God will gather you, and from there He will bring you."

Deut. 30:5, "Then the LORD your God will bring you to the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it. He will prosper you and multiply you more than your fathers.

Deut. 30:6, "And the LORD your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, to love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live."

Jer. 3:13, " 'Only acknowledge your iniquity, that you have transgressed against the LORD your God, and have scattered your charms to alien deities under every green tree, and you have not obeyed My voice,' says the LORD.

Jer. 3:14, " 'Return, O backsliding children,' says the LORD; 'for I am married to you. I will take you, one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion.' "


Jer. 3:15, "And I will give you shepherds according to My heart, who will feed you with knowledge and understanding.

Jer. 3:16, " 'Then it shall come to pass, when you are multiplied and increased in the land in those days,' says the LORD, 'that they will say no more, "The ark of the covenant of the LORD." It shall not come to mind, nor shall they remember it, nor shall they visit it, nor shall it be made anymore.' "


Jer. 3:17, "At that time Jerusalem shall be called the

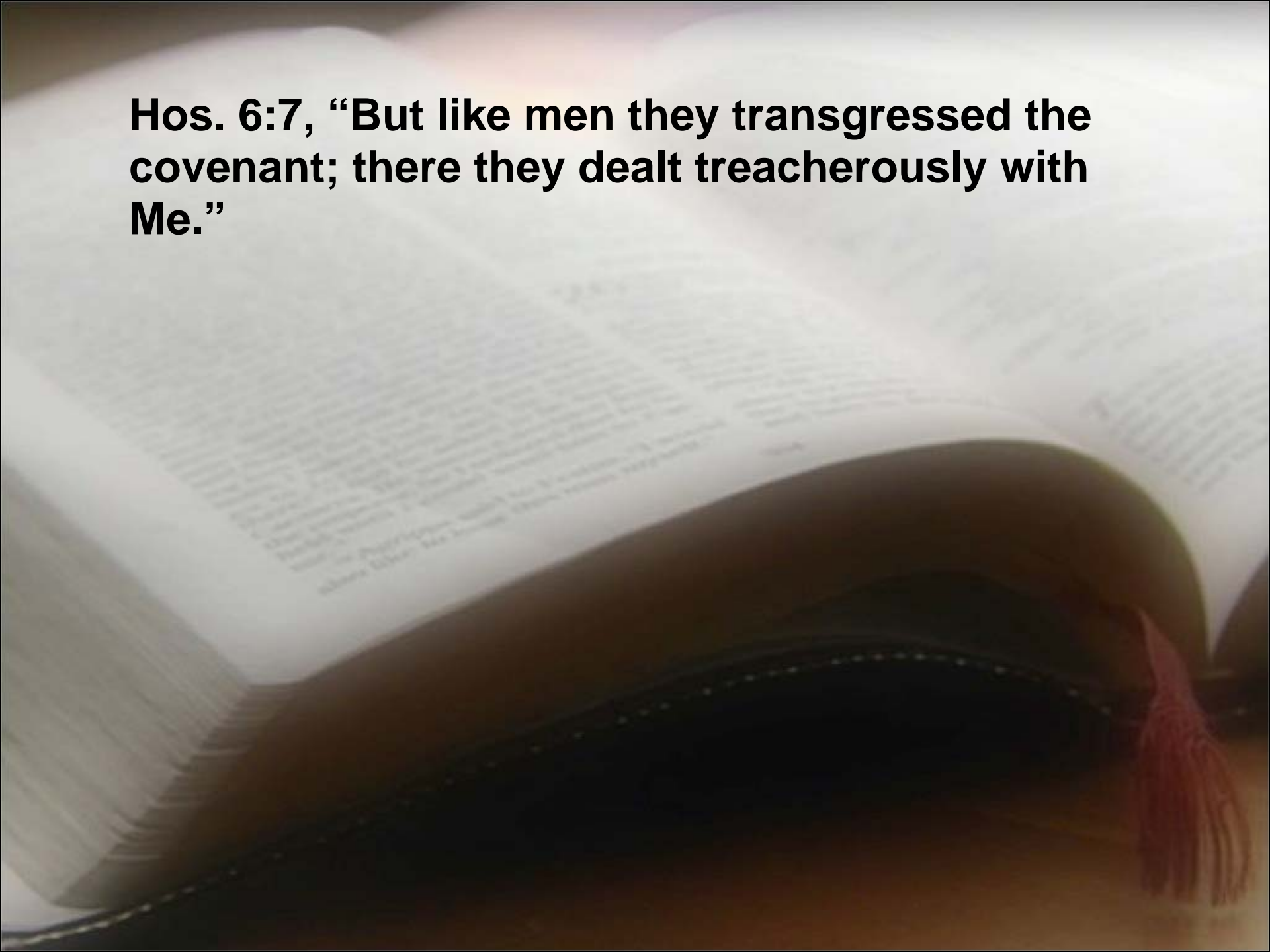
**Hos. 6:1, “Come, and let us return to the LORD;
