


- 6. Second Coming of Christ







The Second Coming of Christ

Rev. 12:14,

"And the two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, in order that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she was nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent."







Mic. 2:12, "I will surely assemble all of you, O Jacob, I will surely gather the remnant of Israel; I will put them together like sheep of the fold [בַּצָרַה botzra], like a flock in the midst of their pasture; They shall make a loud noise because of so many people."

Isa. 34:1, "Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it.

Isa. 34:2, "For the indignation of the LORD is against all nations, and His fury against all their armies; He has utterly destroyed them, He has given them over to the slaughter."

Isa. 34:3, "Also their slain shall be thrown out; their stench shall rise from their corpses, and the mountains shall be melted with their blood.

Isa. 34:4, "All the host of heaven shall be dissolved, and the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll; all their host shall fall down as the leaf falls from the vine, and as fruit falling from a fig tree."

Isa. 34:5, "For My sword shall be bathed in heaven; indeed it shall come down on Edom, and on the people of My curse, for judgment.

Isa. 34:6, "The sword of the LORD is filled with blood, it is made overflowing with fatness, with the blood of lambs and goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams. For the LORD has a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughter in the land of Edom."

Isa. 34:7, "The wild oxen shall come down with them, and the young bulls with the mighty bulls; their land shall be soaked with blood, and their dust saturated with fatness."



Isa. 63:1, "Who is this who comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah, this One who is glorious in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength?— 'I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save.'

Isa. 63:2, "Why is Your apparel red, and Your garments like one who treads in the winepress?"



Isa. 63:3, "I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger, and trampled them in My fury; their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have stained all My robes.

Isa. 63:4, "For the day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come."



Isa. 63:5, "I looked, but there was no one to help, and I wondered that there was no one to uphold; therefore My own arm brought salvation for Me; and My own fury, it sustained Me.

Isa. 63:6, "I have trodden down the peoples in My anger, made them drunk in My fury, and brought down their strength to the earth."

Hab. 3:3, "God came from Teman, the Holy One from Mount Paran. Selah. His glory covered the heavens, and the earth was full of His praise."



Jude 14, "Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, 'Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints,

Jude 15, "to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."

Rev. 19:17, "Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, 'Come and gather together for the supper of the great God,

Rev. 19:18, "that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great."

Rev. 19:21, "And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh."

Ezek. 39:17, "And as for you, son of man, thus says the Lord GOD, 'Speak to every sort of bird and to every beast of the field: "Assemble yourselves and come; gather together from all sides to My sacrificial meal which I am sacrificing for you, a great sacrificial meal on the mountains of Israel, that you may eat flesh and drink blood.

Ezek. 39:18, "'"You shall eat the flesh of the mighty, drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams and lambs, of goats and bulls, all of them fatlings of Bashan.

Ezek. 39:19, "'"You shall eat fat till you are full, and drink blood till you are drunk, at My sacrificial meal which I am sacrificing for you.

Ezek. 39:20, " ' "You shall be filled at My table with horses and riders, with mighty men and with all the men of war," 'says the Lord GOD."

Ezek. 39:21, "I will set My glory among the nations; all the nations shall see My judgment which I have executed, and My hand which I have laid on them.

Ezek. 39:22, "So the house of Israel shall know that I am the LORD their God from that day forward."

Ezek. 39:23, "The Gentiles shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity; because they were unfaithful to Me, therefore I hid My face from them. I gave them into the hand of their enemies, and they all fell by the sword.

Ezek. 39:24, "According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions I have dealt with them, and hidden My face from them."


Ezek. 39:25, "Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: 'Now I will bring back the captives of Jacob, and have mercy on the whole house of Israel; and I will be jealous for My holy name—

Ezek. 39:26, "'after they have borne their shame, and all their unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me, when they dwelt safely in their own land and no one made them afraid."

Ezek. 39:27, "When I have brought them back from the peoples and gathered them out of their enemies' lands, and I am hallowed in them in the sight of many nations,

Ezek. 39:28, "then they shall know that I am the LORD their God, who sent them into captivity among the nations, but also brought them back to their land, and left none of them captive any longer."

Ezek. 39:29, "'And I will not hide My face from them anymore; for I shall have poured out My Spirit on the house of Israel,' says the Lord GOD."



Zech. 12:7, "The LORD will save the tents of Judah first, so that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem shall not become greater than that of Judah."




Zechariah 14:3-4

- 4 "On that day his feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, east of Jerusalem..."


Zechariah 14:4-5

- 4 "On that day his feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, east of Jerusalem, and the Mount of Olives will be split in two from east to west, forming a great valley, with half of the mountain moving north and half moving south.
- 5 "You will flee by my mountain valley, for it will extend to Azel. You will flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Then the LORD my God will come, and all the holy ones with him."

Joel 3:14-17

- 14 "Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision! For the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision.
- 15 "The sun and moon will be darkened, and the stars no longer shine."

Joel 3 Con't

- 16 "The LORD will roar from Zion and thunder from Jerusalem; the earth and the sky will tremble. But the LORD will be a refuge for his people, a stronghold for the people of Israel.
- 17 "Then you will know that I, the LORD your God, dwell in Zion, my holy hill. Jerusalem will be holy; never again will foreigners invade her."

And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, 'KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS." "
