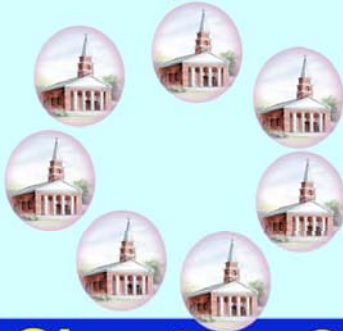

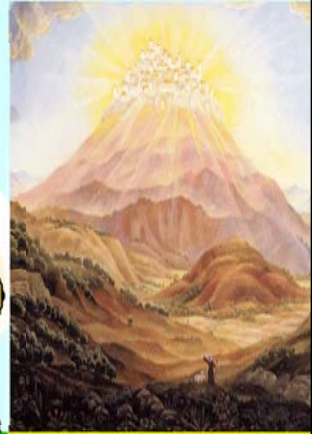

**Imminency: the “at any moment” return of Jesus Christ.**

**OED: “hanging overhead, constantly ready to befall or overtake one; close at hand in its incidence.”**

It is **certain** it will occur,  
it is **uncertain** when it will occur.

It is not contingent on any other  
events, and no prophesied event  
intervenes between the believer and  
the Rapture.

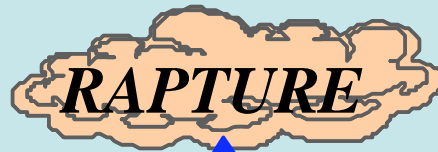
**2. The doctrine of imminency is important to understanding the Pre-Tribulation return of Jesus Christ at the Rapture.**

**The Rapture will occur before the Tribulation and will include all believers.**



**3. The purpose of the doctrine of imminency is to keep each believer in a constant state of expectancy, looking, waiting, watching, hoping for the return of Christ that we might be ready, prepared, that we might not be ashamed at His coming (1 John 2:28).**

**4. Believers are to look for the blessed hope.**

**a. We are to LOOK for the Savior.  
Heb. 9:28; Titus 2:13**

**b. We are to WATCH for the Savior.  
1 Thess. 5:6; Luke 12:37**

**c. We are to WAIT for the Savior.  
1 Cor. 1:7; 1 Thess. 1:10**

**Matthew 24:36, “But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone.**

**Matthew 24:37, “For the coming of the Son of Man will be just like the days of Noah.**

**Matthew 24:38, “For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark,”**

**5. No prophecy between the baptism of the Spirit and the Rapture means that the Rapture is imminent. It could occur at any time; no one knows the day or the hour.**

**6. While the Rapture is imminent, the Second Advent is not. Before the Second Advent occurs, there are many prophecies which must occur, e.g., the Rapture, the Tribulation, the Judgment Seat of Christ, Rev. 6–19.**

**2 Pet. 3:3, “Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with their mocking, following after their own lusts,”**

**John 14:1, “Let not your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me.**

**John 14:2, “In My Father’s house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you.**

**John 14:3, “And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.”**

**Rev. 22:12, “Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to render to every man according to what he has done.”**



**James 5:7, “Be patient, therefore, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. Behold, the farmer waits for the precious produce of the soil, being patient about it, until it gets the early and late rains.**

**No one can expect Christ's coming to be delayed, we must be prepared each day.**

**No date can be set.**

**No prophecy needs to be fulfilled before the Rapture can take place.**

**μακάριος, *makarios* – to be happy because of circumstances, to be privileged, happy, fortunate. Probably here privilege due to described circumstances.**

articular participle present active  
nominative masculine singular; to  
read publicly, to read aloud**

**1 Tim. 4:13, “Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.”**

**James 1:22, “But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.”**

**James 1:25, “But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.”**

injustice, deal unjustly, injure**

**ρυπαρός (*rhyparos*), dirty, filthy**

**δίκαιος (*dikaios*), righteous**

**ἅγιος (*hagios*)**
