The Epistle to the ROMANS

Promises of a Divine Messiah Romans 9:3–5; Isaiah 9:6; Micah 5:2

John 1:1-5; Col. 1:15-17; Hebrews 1:3



A Human and Divine Messiah

Isaiah 9:6, "For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father [אֲבִיעֵר], abi'adh, father of eternity, i.e., eternal one], Prince of Peace."

Isa. 8:21, "They will pass through it hard-pressed and hungry; and it shall happen, when they are hungry, that they will be enraged and curse their king and their God, and look upward.

Isa. 8:22, "Then they will look to the earth, and see trouble and darkness, gloom of anguish; and they will be driven into darkness."

Isa. 9:1, "Nevertheless [Because] the gloom will not be upon her who is distressed, as when at first He lightly esteemed the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, and afterward more heavily oppressed her, by the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, in Galilee of the Gentiles.

Isa. 9:2, "The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; Those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, upon them a light has shined."

Isa. 9:6, "For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Isa. 9:7, "Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this."

"And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."

Mic. 5:2, "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of you shall come forth to Me the One to be Ruler in Israel, whose goings forth are <u>from of old, from everlasting</u>."



Jer. 23:5, "'Behold, the days are coming,' declares the Lord, 'When I will raise up for David a righteous Branch; And He will reign as king and act wisely and do justice and righteousness in the land.

Jer. 23:6, "In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely; And this is His name by which He will be called, "The Lord [Yhwh] our righteousness"."
