

nom fem sing salvation, "deliverance, preservation" denote rescue and deliverance in the sense of averting some danger threatening life

Heb. 9:28, "so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation."

1 Pet. 1:5, "who are kept by the power of God through faith for <u>salvation</u> ready to be revealed in the last time."
